

Summer 2013 Learning Recovery Begins July 1 (Six Week Standard Session/Eight Week Extended)*

VTVLC will be offering an online, six-week credit-recovery program that begins on July 1, 2013. This program allows students to pretest and identify specific content areas within the course to complete with the support of a Vermont licensed teacher. All courses will be offered online and do not require the student to attend class in person.

VTVLC online credit recovery program is for students

- who need to make up credits to graduate on schedule;
- have other commitments and need flexible scheduling;
- could benefit from a different learning environment.

VTVLC-trained teachers conduct the online classes, which are designed to equate to approximately 120 minutes of instruction per day. Students can take VTVLC Summer School courses any time, any place, allowing for greater flexibility in their summer plans.

Summer School courses are offered during this six-week sessions and are designed to provide students with enrichment or credit recovery for one high school semester. VTVLC also offers an extension to the four-week program for students who may require more flexibility.

The six-week session registration fee is \$275. Partner school students receive a 15% discount for the six week session.

*The extended session fee of \$125 allows students to take up to an additional 2 weeks (8 weeks total) to complete the program. Seats are limited, so register early. You will be notified on June 28 if the class you have chosen will not run due to low enrollments.

Please note the summer enrollment period begins on March 15, 2013 and ends on June 26, 2013. If a student elects to drop their course, no refunds will be granted. For more information, please contact summer@vtvlc.org.
